



Case Study: Beechmont Country Club

Our Client

Beechmont Country Club was established in 1923 when a group of seven men recognized the need for another club to sustain the growing Jewish population in the Cleveland area. These seven men became charter members of Beechmont Country Club when it was incorporated on April 3, 1923.

In June of 1963 Beechmont was on the National stage when they played host to the Inaugural Cleveland Open. At the time, this was the largest purse ever played for in the history of golf. Nicklaus, Palmer, Snead, and

Trevino were just a few of the names that were here to play for their share of the \$110,000 purse. Beechmont has become the premier family club on the east side of Cleveland offering both indoor and outdoor Tennis Courts, Summer Day Camp, Pool, Dining and an 18-hole Championship Golf Course.
