As you know GOOD data in equals GOOD data out! Help the Renewables team create the best proposal for your clients by following some of the guidelines below.

Solar PIF -Do's

- Fill out the client information completely and neatly, including pages 7 & 8
- Attach a Google Earth (satellite) image of the project's location with a proposed array location <u>Learn How</u>
- Send in 12 months of client energy bills
- Correctly indicate the tax status of the client. Tax credits and incentives are often linked to the client's tax status.

Solar PIF - Don'ts

- Send a photo of the completed PIF, it is difficult to read and adds more time to the proposal process Please scan and upload the PIF
- Send in usage data only. Always send the actual bill whenever possible. A spreadsheet with usage information is not as accurate as the real thing

Ideal Data - Speed Up the Proposal Process

- 12 months of electric bills separated by meter and in chronological order.
- Known project constraints. -> Safety requirements, roof conditions, and/or things that might get in the way and/or affect installation.
